Depending on number of registrations the BC1/BC2 and the BC4/BC5/Open may be divided into two separate throwers competitions.

Classification

There will be no official classifiers at this event so any potential new athletes will be classed into a classification in which the event coordinator decides, and all competitors shall respect this circumstance.



COVID-19 SAFETY REQUIREMENTS & DISCLAIMER

Key Aspects/Principles:

The health and safety of our members, participants, coaches, officials, administrators/volunteers, visitors, families and the broader community is a high priority and of upmost importance to us. Since the outbreak of COVID-19, ParaQuad Tasmania has been closely monitoring Federal and State Service announcements, following the guidelines from these agencies and implementing initiatives and closures where necessary to ensure the health and safety of our members, participants, coaches, officials, administrators/volunteers, visitors and the broader community.

Please be assured that facilities are assessed, and appropriate plans are in place to accommodate upgraded hygiene protocols, physical distancing and other measures to mitigate the risk of transmission of COVID-19. Spectators will be required to sign in on arrival.

At every stage leading up to, during and at completion of the event/challenge ParaQuad Tasmania will apply all applicable State and Territory Government and local restrictions and regulations. ParaQuad Tasmania is prepared for any localised outbreak at our facilities, within our competitions or whilst carrying out events in the local community.

Registration Cancellation Due to Covid-19 Related Causes:

Government regulations may change at short notice, so any Covid-19 related cancellation requests will be considered. We reserve the right to cancel registration at short notice in the event that Government regulations change/stipulate this requirement.

Hygiene, any safe hygiene protocols distributed by the venue will be adopted by ParaQuad Tasmania including:

- Availability of hand sanitiser at entry/exit points to venue and elsewhere
- Protocols for sanitising stations, sanitising shared equipment
- Avoid sharing of equipment
- Regular cleaning of high touch surfaces i.e., pens & clipboards

Practicing Good Hygiene:

You should practice good hygiene, including avoiding touching your face, eyes, nose or mouth.

When washing your hands health and safety guidelines recommend washing your hands for at least 20 seconds and drying them with clean paper towel. Use alcohol-based hand rub if unable to wash your hands with soap and water, provided by ParaQuad onsite.





Washing hands should occur:

- Before and after eating
- After coughing or sneezing (into elbow/tissue)
- After going to the toilet
- · When changing tasks
- After touching potentially contaminated surfaces

We are also ensuring our employees are supported with clear health and good hygiene protocols, as well as providing them with information and support to stay at home if they are unwell for any reason.

What Should You Do If You Develop COVID-19 Symptoms Prior to The Event/Challenge?

Should you develop symptoms suggestive of COVID-19 such as fever, dry cough or tiredness or get a positive laboratory test for SARS-CoV-2 prior to the event, please notify us to discuss options for cancellation of your registration to participate.

What Should You Do If You Develop COVID-19 Symptoms During the Course of the Event/Challenge?

If you develop COVID-19 symptoms during the event, such as fever, dry cough or tiredness, you should notify the event organiser, leave the venue, isolate immediately and seek medical attention.

If you have serious symptoms such as difficulty breathing:

 Call 000, ask for an ambulance and notify the officers if you have been in contact with anyone with COVID-19

Please notify us if you develop Covid-19 symptoms or receive a positive laboratory test for SARS-CoV-2 so that we can take steps to ensure the health and safety of all of our members, participants, coaches, officials, administrators/volunteers, visitors, families and the broader community.



Management of Unwell Participants:

Players, members, volunteers, and their families who show the onset of any symptoms will be required to go home or enter an isolation area until it is practical for them to go home. Sport facilities operators will be notified that a participant at the facility has shown symptoms.

All ParaQuad Tasmania staff and volunteers will be required to do the COVID-19 Infection Control Training prior to the event. ParaQuad Tasmania will notify the relevant public health authorities and other attendees of confirmed symptomatic participants.
