## Introduction:

It will also allow us to provide other participation, pathway and performance activations, activities and events that will coincide with or run before/after a competition. (ie: Coach Workshops & PD, Come & Try day, Talent ID days, Camps etc). And allow for competition prior to international events and further support our What it takes to win strategy.

If your application is successful and we have negotiated a suitable date in the calendar, we are pleased to offer the following funding to support the running of your event:

Nationals (BANT):	\$5000.00 (x 1 grant only)
State Titles:	\$2000.00 (max 4 grants available)
Club competition:	\$ 250.00 (max 10 grants available)
